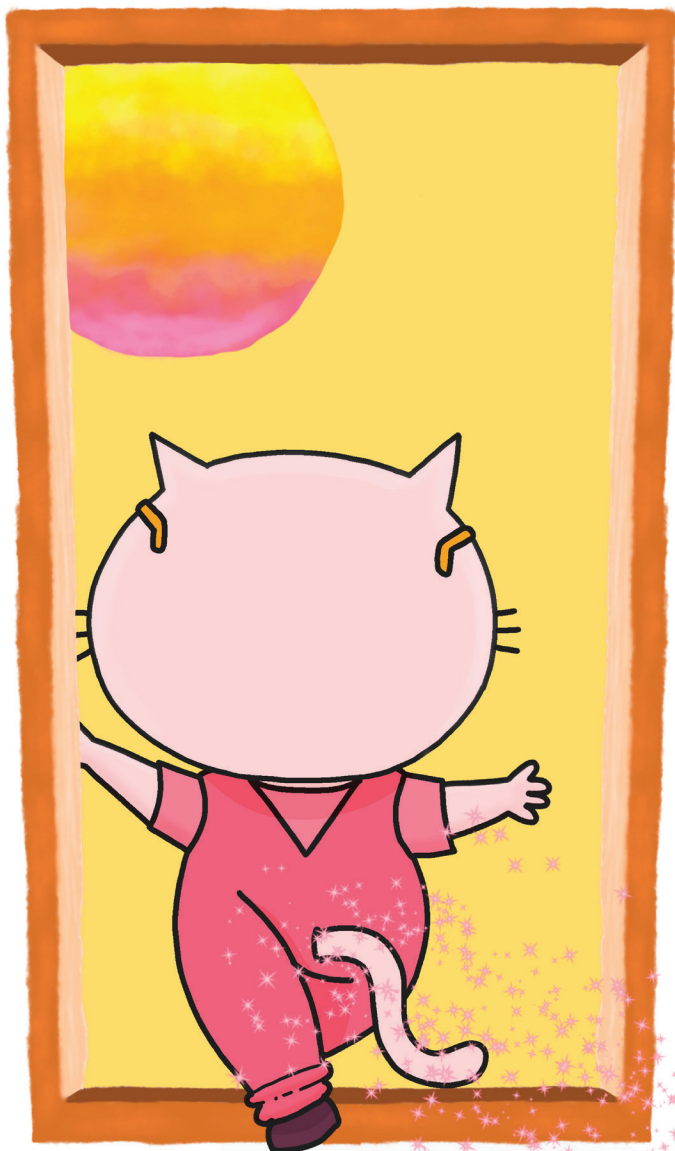




"You are right!" says **Sparkle Kitty**. "The sunglasses will protect my eyes from the **BRIGHT** sunlight."

sunlight," says

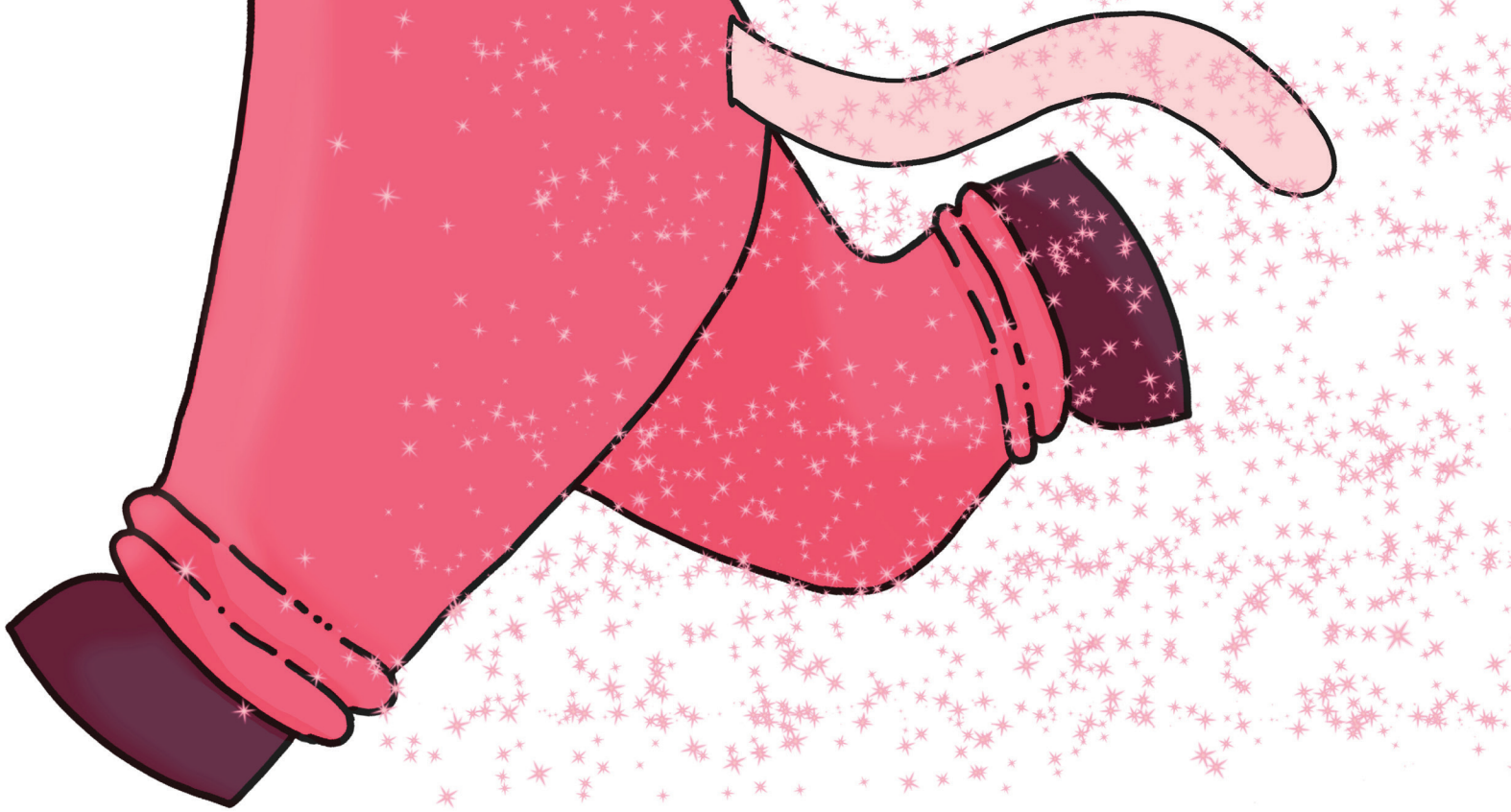
Sparkle Kitty.

go outside.



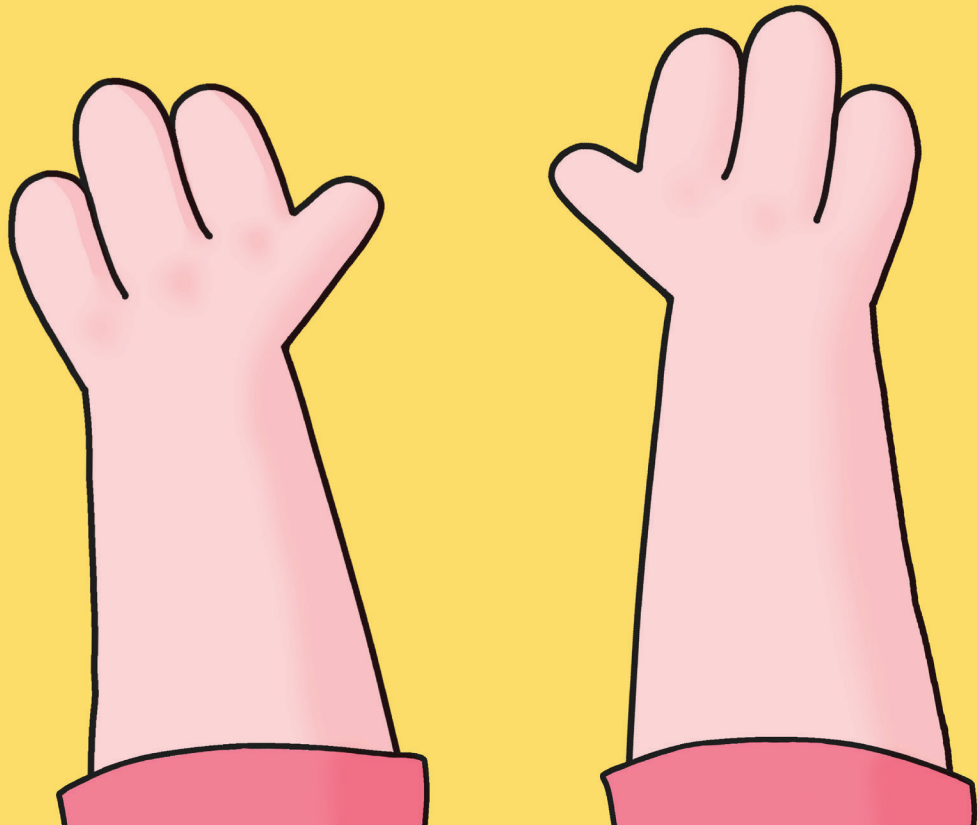
**"Oh no!"**

from the sunlight?

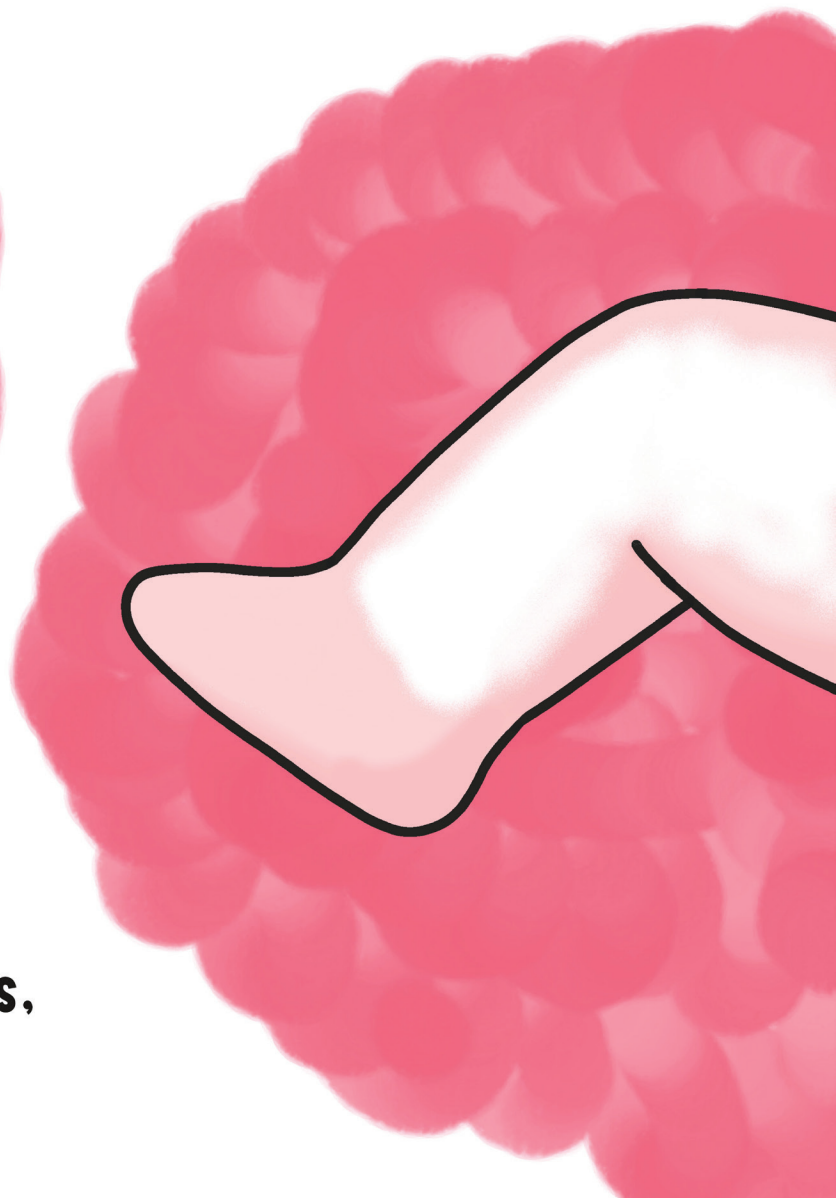
That's right! The sunscreen will help protect

their tail.**



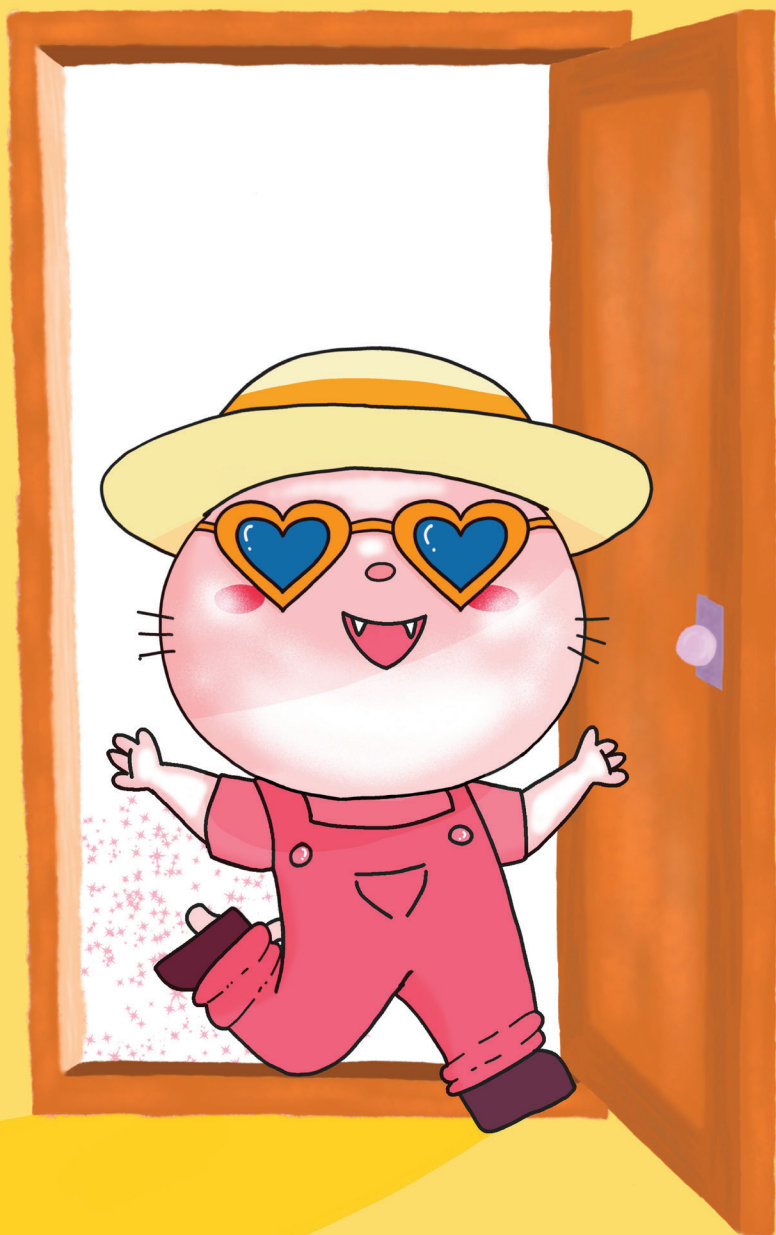
Remember to put sunscreen on

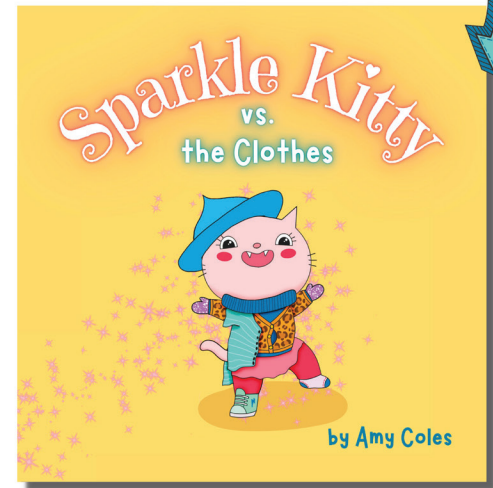
## Meet the Author
